FESTIVAL INFORMATION AND RULES FOR 2023

TIME AND LOCATION:

>The festival will be held in the Downtown Plaza and adjacent areas on Saturday October 7, 2023, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

>**Setup time is from 6:00 AM until 8:00 AM on October 7, 2023. Streets must be cleared of all vehicles as soon as merchandise can be unloaded but no later than 8:00 AM.**

>Take down time is from 5:00 PM until 7:00 PM that same day.

>Vendors must remain for the duration of the festival. Absolutely no vehicles will be allowed to Delmas Avenue, Canty Street, Magnolia Street, or Watts Avenue after initial setup.

OUTSIDE FESTIVAL * WEATHER WILL DETERMINE CANCELLATION *** NO REFUNDS**

>A vendor is any individual, club, church, sorority or business selling goods at the Zonta Arts and Crafts Festival.

>**Booth Spaces CANNOT BE RE-RENTED OR SOLD BY VENDOR. If the vendor whose application is accepted by Zonta unable to attend, space reverts to ZONTA.**

>Vendor fee (**postmarked by August 31, 2023**) will be \$100.00 per vendor space without electricity and \$105.00 with one (1) electrical outlet.

>ALL food booth application (**postmarked by August 31, 2023**) will be \$110.00 per space. All food booths include one electrical outlet.

>**ALL applications postmarked AFTER August 31, 2023, will be 125.00 per space with or without electricity, craft or food booths.**

>**FINAL REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS SEPTEMBER 15, 2023. Applications postmarked after September 15th will not be accepted and vendor will be notified.**

>**Money will NOT be refunded for cancellations received after September 1st, 2023.**

>Notification of cancellation will be greatly appreciated.

>Space assignments will be made on a first come basis.

>Vendors will be notified of space assignments by email or mail before the festival. If you register between September 1st and September 15th and have no email address, you will need to pick up your packet at the Information Booth the day of the festival.

>Any vendor deemed inappropriate for the show by the Arts & Crafts Chairperson may be asked to leave.

FOOD:

>Food (for immediate consumption) cannot be sold from the same booth as arts and crafts.

>Food exhibitors must provide their own fuel source.

>Garbage remaining after Festival must be bagged.

SPACE:

>**Size of the space shall be approximately 10' x 10' for Arts and Crafts displays and 15' x 10' for Food Booths. Some adjustments will be made this year to space locations, so spaces may be shifted slightly.**

>The festival is outdoors with some spots partially shaded. The majority are in full sun on concrete.

PROMOTION:

>The number of vendors expected to participate is approximately 250. Crowds are expected to be between 15,000 and 20,000.

>ZONTA will advertise this Festival in local, state, and regional media.

SETUP/LOADING:

>No equipment is provided. Tables, chairs, screens and canopies are the responsibility of the vendor.

>Loading and unloading is the responsibility of the vendor. Vendors will park in designated parking lots.

>Only 110 volts of electricity is available on a very limited basis and must be requested and approved by ZONTA at the time of application.

>**If you have requested electricity, please bring a 100 ft heavy duty extension cord.**

SECURITY:

>Law enforcement officials will be present for the duration of the festival.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS AND PRECAUTIONS:

>Mississippi Law requires collection of MS state Tax of 7% by exhibitors and 9% for all FOOD SOLD.

>Vendors must remain with and are responsible for their booth except for breaks and errands. During those times, someone must be specified to stay with the merchandise.

>INVERTER" (quiet) GENERATORS ALLOWED IN FOOD BOOTHS ONLY. (If your generator is too loud, Zonta reserves the right to have the generator disconnected).

Zonta Club of Pascagoula Area shall not be responsible or liable for any injury or loss that may arise or come to lessee, or his/her employees or goods, for any cause whatsoever. Zonta Club of Pascagoula Area does not provide insurance for vendors. Vendor relieves Zonta Club of Pascagoula Area and the property owners of responsibility in connection with the safe keeping of property during the festival.
